

Front-Line Farm LLC Equestrian Facility

Waiver and Release of Liability

Under Ohio law, an equine activity sponsor or equine professional is not liable for an injury to, or the death of, a participant in equine activities resulting from the inherent risks of equine activities. This document shall be governed by the laws of the State of Ohio.

You acknowledge that, pursuant to R.C. 2305.321, by participating in equine activities, including but not limited to, trail rides, riding instruction, caring for equines, and/or recreational rides, you are an equine activity participant. As an equine activity participant, you are subject to the inherent risk of an equine activity as defined in R.C. 2305.321 as a danger or condition that is an integral part of an equine activity, including, but not limited to, any of the following:

1. The propensity of an equine to behave in ways that may result in injury, death, or loss to persons on or around the equine;
2. The unpredictability of an equine's reaction to sounds, sudden movement, unfamiliar objects, persons, or other animals;
3. Hazards, including, but not limited to, surface or subsurface conditions, tack malfunctions;
4. A collision with another equine, another animal, a person, or an object;
5. The potential of an equine activity participant to act in a negligent manner that may contribute to injury, death, or loss to the person of the participant or to other persons, including, but not limited to, failing to maintain control over an equine or failing to act within the ability of the participant.

By signing this written waiver, you acknowledge that the equine activity participant who is the subject of this waiver, as well as the parent, guardian, custodian, or other legal representative of the equine activity participant who is the subject of this waiver if such participant is under 18 years of age, does not have a claim or cause of action upon which a recovery of damages may be based against, and may not recover damages in court or other civil action against, any and all equine activity sponsors, other equine activity participants, equine professionals, veterinarians, farriers, or other persons associated with this activity, including, but not limited to, Front-Line Farm LLC.

Do you understand that inherent risks include:

yes no The propensity of an equine to behave in ways that may result in injury, death, or loss to persons on or around the equine;

yes no The unpredictability of an equine's reaction to sounds, sudden movement, unfamiliar objects, persons, or other animals;

yes no Hazards, including, but not limited to, surface or subsurface conditions, tack malfunctions;

yes no A collision with another equine, another animal, a person, or an object;

yes no The potential of an equine activity participant to act in a negligent manner that may contribute to injury, death, or loss to the person of the participant or to other persons, including, but not limited to, failing to maintain control over an equine or failing to act within the ability of the participant.

yes no Participant recognizes that helmets are required and agrees to always wear a helmet and proper footwear while participating in Horse-related activities. Participant understands and agrees that a helmet is in no way a guarantee of safety and that no helmet can protect wearer against all foreseeable impacts to the head. Participant also understands that the helmet does not guard against injury to the neck, spine or any other part of the body, and that these limitations are inherent risks of Horse-related activities. If you are to be a rider in an instructional course, have you been advised to wear, and if you are under 18 years will you wear, ASTM/SEI approved headgear; (If you do not own headgear Front-Line Farm LLC may provide one to you; however, Front-Line Farm LLC does not warrant the usability, suitability, or manufacture of any such headgear, and by accepting such headgear you agree to wear one at your own risk.)

yes no Will you carry health, accident, and/or major medical insurance to cover any injuries you may receive because of an equine activity;

I HAVE READ THE FOREGOING and do hereby for my heirs, administrators, executors and assigns hereby release, acquit and forever discharge Front-Line Farm LLC, its employees and agents of same, and their heirs, administrators, executors and assigns from any and all claims, causes of action, damages, or lawsuits which may accrue on, account of, or in any way growing out of injuries, as a result of any equine (Horse or Pony, whether owned by Participant, Facility or Third Party) activity at Front-Line Farm LLC.

I understand that by signing this Waiver and Release of Liability, I am giving up my right to sue and that I will ultimately bear the loss if I should successfully sue and recover damages.
